

Application for the Tennessee Secretary of State's  
**Anne Dallas Dudley Award**

For the first time in state history, the Tennessee Secretary of State is presenting the Anne Dallas Dudley Award to high schools across the state. To qualify, at least 85% of eligible students, 18 and older by the next election, must be registered to vote at the time of submission. Submissions will be accepted up until March 31, 2022.



**Gold Level:** 100% of eligible students, 18 and older by the next election, are registered to vote. The Secretary of State's office will present the school with a commemorative plaque and present certificates to Student Ambassadors.

**Silver Level:** 85% of eligible students, 18 and older by the next election, are registered to vote. The Secretary of State's office will mail certificates to Student Ambassadors.

*Anne Dallas Dudley was a national and state leader in the fight for women's suffrage who worked tirelessly to secure the ratification of the 19th Amendment in Tennessee.*
