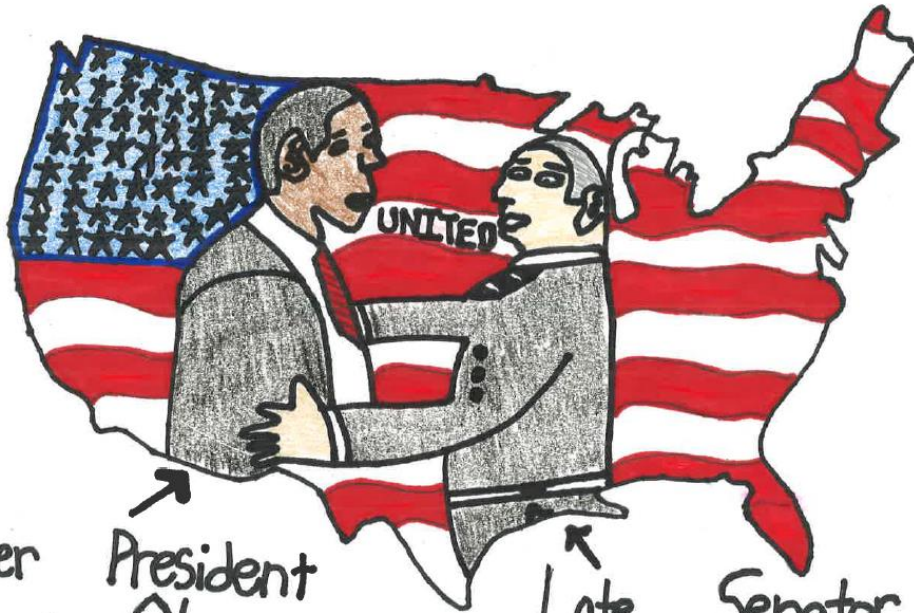


What is a Great Leader?
