INTRODUCTION

The Beersheba Springs Historical Society (via Janelle Taylor) loaned The Beersheba Springs Historical Society Subject Files, 1806-1983, for microfilming. The collection consists of items relating to the history of Beersheba Springs and its historical society. The collection consists of 3.5 cubic feet. There are no restrictions on this collection.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Beersheba Springs Historical Society Subject Files, 1806-1983, consists of several individual family histories and photographs for the Creighton, Green, King, Pease, Savage, and Tate families. Also included are numerous Grundy County records which include cemeteries, census records, newspaper clippings, court records, history notes, schools, churches, birth, marriage, and death records. The collection also contains historical material on Burritt College, Irving College, Warren County, and Sumner County. There are two ledgers included in this collection: Beersheba Springs Hotel Company, 1879, and H. B. Northcutt General Merchandise, Altamont, Tennessee, December 1858-December 1959. There are also several items concerning the Beersheba Springs Historical Society, such as financial records, newspaper clippings, and newsletters.
