INTRODUCTION

Allan Kerns of Dickson, Tennessee loaned The Bon Aqua Resort Ledger microfilming. The ledger includes account information for the Bon Aqua Resort, 1902-1905. The collection consists of .5 cubic feet, and there are no restrictions.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Bon Aqua Springs Resort in Hickman County, Tennessee, was once the largest health spa and summer retreat in Middle Tennessee. It was known as the “Queen of the Southern Spas” during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. The Bon Aqua Springs Resort ledger contains account information for the items purchased to feed guests and run the spa between 1902 and 1905.
