## **INTRODUCTION**

Joe Howard Brown, of Springfield, Tennessee, compiled the Brown Family Genealogical Materials (Jackson County, Tennessee) and loaned them to the State Library and Archives for microfilming. The collection consists of 2.5 cubic feet and retains its original order. There are no restrictions.

## **SCOPE AND CONTENT**

The Brown Family Genealogical Materials (Jackson County, Tennessee) consists primarily of photocopied research regarding Thomas Brown (1773-1862) and his descendants. Thomas Brown moved from Fincastle, Virginia, to Jackson County, Tennessee, around 1800 and purchased land along the Dry Fork of Flynn's Creek. After his wife Nancy's death, he married Elizabeth Billingsley. Included in the collection are biographical sketches, photos, maps, land grants, certificates, articles, muster rolls, correspondence, and genealogical charts.
