INTRODUCTION

Claudia C. Bonnyman of Nashville, Tennessee loaned The Claudia C. Bonnyman Collection, 1844-1961, for microfilming. The collection largely consists of items relating to William G. Brownlow (1805-1877). The collection consists of 1.5 cubic feet, and there are no restrictions.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Claudia C. Bonnyman Collection, 1844-1961, contains correspondence from J. B. Ashe to William G. Brownlow, 1844, regarding state matters; a pamphlet concerning the appointment of General Longstreet as Surveyor of Customs for the Port of New Orleans; and a sketch of Brownlow titled "The Home of Senator William G. Brownlow." The collection also includes numerous newspaper clippings concerning the life and career of Brownlow along with two buttons, which were not microfilmed.
