INTRODUCTION

George W. Reed of Winchester, Tennessee loaned The Tims Ford Dam and State Park Scrapbooks and J. W. Weaver Interview Transcript, 1962-1994 to the Tennessee State Library and Archives. The Tennessee State Library and Archives returned the materials to the owner after filming.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Tims Ford Dam and State Park Scrapbooks and J. W. Weaver Interview Transcript consist primarily of five scrapbooks dating from 1962-1980. Compiled by Clayton and Louise Ervin, the scrapbooks are a history of Tims Ford Dam located in Franklin and Moore Counties, Tennessee. They include newspaper and periodical clippings, copies of legal records, and correspondence.

Also included is a transcript of an interview with J. W. Weaver conducted by Tims Ford State Park Manager Bob Rees, Regional Interpreter John Froeschauer, and Seasonal Naturalist Shane Farnor, dated 1994.
